

Overview of malaria collaborative research

Introduction

- Collaborative malaria research activities between LSHTM and NIMR/KCMC were intensified after the establishment of Joint Malaria Partnership (JMP) in 2001.
- JMP is a partnership between four institutions, namely LSHTM, NIMR, CMP and KCMC.
- Initial malaria research projects were supported by British Medical Research Council, Gates Malaria Partnership and DANIDA.
- JMP has offered direct or indirect support to a total number of 22 MSc and 12 PhD trainees, mostly from local institutions.
